South Africa, where the warm waters of the Indian Ocean meet the cold waters of the Atlantic Ocean. In these beautiful waters, you have the opportunity of a lifetime to view the majesty of the world's largest creatures, whales. Between June and November you can enjoy the spectacular sight of these impressive mammals from the shore or from a charter boat. Without a doubt this is an experience you do not want to miss.

Southern Right Whales make their way from the Atlantic to the Western Cape's coast to give birth and nurse their young. The Whale Route stretches from Cape Town all the way to Durban, past beautiful locations such as Tsitsikamma and the Garden Route. Hermanus is probably the best known whale watching location and for good reason, as from its rocky cliffs you can get a close view of the magnificent water mammals.

The holidays in this e-brochure give you the opportunity to see whales, although, of course, we cannot guarantee sightings. For further details of these itineraries, please visit our website.

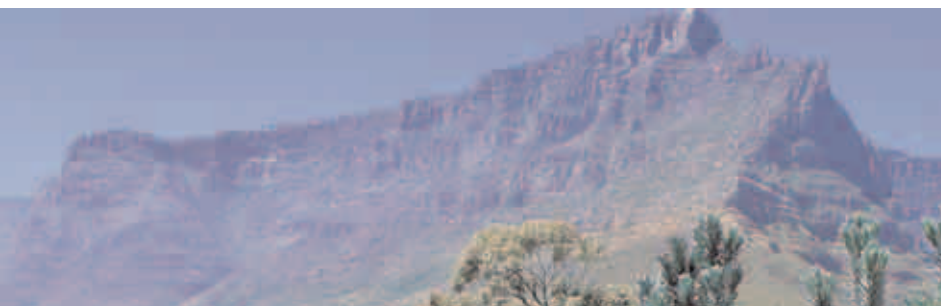
